CAMS wins Capital Markets contest

Sponsored by California Council on Economic Education & the Los Angeles Society of Financial Analysts

For the second time in the four years CAMS students came out on top and won first place in the Capital Markets contest sponsored by the California Council on Economic Education & the Los Angeles Society of Financial Analysts. Competing against Los Angeles and Santa Barbara county schools, this year's team of 12th-graders Nikolas Martelaro, Dora Dura, Jamal Saleh, Emma Ogiemwanye, and Daniel Hwang participated in a 10-week stock market contest with a simulated \$100,000 portfolio, wrote an essay evaluating and interpreting recent trends in fiscal and monetary policy and their interactions with world affairs, and made a verbal presentation reviewing the implications of important current economic and financial forces and their effect on the economy and the stock market.

All five students and their 12th-grade social studies teacher Greg Fisher were awarded \$500 and a trip to New York where they will visit the New York Stock Exchange and the Federal Reserve in the summer.
